Course Description:

This ICI foundation specialty course provides investigators with the knowledge, skills and techniques for recognizing and investigating an environmental crime. This course is designed for law enforcement investigators and government regulators who investigate environmental crimes and is modeled in adult based learning. This course includes instruction in: environmental crimes terminology, crime scene safety considerations and management, law and regulations, resources and allied agencies, access and search warrants, evidence collection, sampling and analysis, interviewing techniques, investigative resources and methods, and case preparation.

Learning Outcomes:

- Interpret and apply laws and regulations related to environmental crime incidents
- Develop case through evidence collection, sampling, and analysis
- Employ proper investigative and interrogation techniques
- Conduct effective interviews
- Understand investigative sources and methods
- Successfully prepare for and assist in the prosecution of an environmental crime case.

- Prior completion of ICI Core Course recommended.
- Completion of Basic Police Academy and DOJ Clearance required.
