

K-9 TRAINING FACILITY



- 15,000 sq. ft. fenced lawn area suitable for obedience, control work, and apprehension training.
- State-of-the-art agility course with an adjustable bar jump, window jump, ladder/plank walk, pipe tunnels, A-frame climb, pyramid barrel climb, and other challenging obstacles.
- The search field is a separate area consisting of a large field with multiple hiding locations such as a shed, dumpsters, and vehicles.
- Large paved area that can be utilized for K9 involving code 3 driving, felony vehicle stops, and vehicle deployment training.
- The Tactical House consists of a three furnished structure that can be used for tactical scenarios, suspect searches or detective training.
- Two kennels are available on site for stowing dogs during training.
- A major benefit of this facility is that it's located at a law enforcement academy in an industrial area, which means there are minimal noise issues in regards to barking dogs, blank guns, yelling, or sirens.

TRACK/OBSTACLE COURSE



- All-weather outdoor quarter-mile track.
- Obstacle course designed for SWAT and other specialized training.
- Surrounding the obstacle course is rubberized bark approx. 8-12 inches deep.

ABOUT US

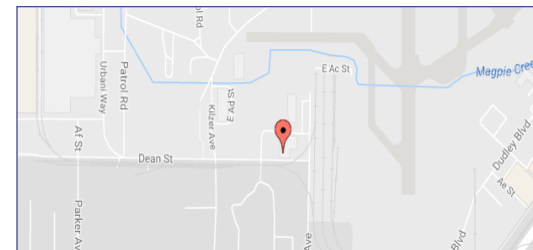

SMALL ARMS FIRING RANGE



RANGE 1

- 25 yard shooting range rated for all pistols, shotguns, and rifles up to .50 BMG.
- 18 remote controlled turning targets.
- Dual "Running Man" moving targets.
- Covered teaching/ break area.
- Drivable concrete surface.

RANGE 2

- 25 yard shooting range, 45' wide.
- Restricted to shotguns only.
- Will accommodate 8 shooters on line safely.
- Drivable asphalt surface.

RANGE 3

- 50 yard shooting range.
- Rated for all pistols, shotguns, and rifles up to .50 BMG.
- 50-25 yd. gravel surface, 25 yd. forward drivable concrete surface.

Rental of Ranges includes target stands, backers, and the use of a classroom. Barricades are available upon request on a first come-first serve basis.

SHOOTING HRS ARE RESTRICTED TO:

0800-2100 hrs. Monday-Saturday

0900-2100 hrs. Sunday



SHOOT HOUSE

- 360° tactical live fire training area.
- Two mechanical breach doors.
- 10 rooms with multiple entry points.
- Restricted to non-toxic, frangible pistol ammo.
- Frangible rifle allowed with prior authorization.



WEIGHT ROOM/ MAT ROOMS

- The 5,000 sq. ft. gymnasium is designed to address all physical fitness needs, including sports performance equipment.
- There are two mat rooms designed for defensive tactics/combat training. Large mat room is approx. 5,000 sq. feet.
- The smaller mat room has folding mats, and a matted wall. Small mat room is approx. 2,500 sq. feet.

TACTICAL VILLAGE FACILITY



- 17,000 sq. ft.
- Facility designed for the use of simunitions or other marking rounds.
- Facility design allows multiple scenarios to be conducted simultaneously.
- 2 interconnecting house floorplans with adjustable breaching doors at each entrance. Entrances and exits to rooms are reconfigurable.
- 48 total rooms, including bathrooms, kitchens, hallways, alleys and attic with crawl space, stairwells and moveable walls.
- Rooms are decorated with furniture props to give the facility a realistic feel.
- Exterior façade to simulate various types of buildings.
- School settings, with classrooms, locker room and hallways. Perfect for active shooter training.
- Overhead steel catwalk for viewing the training.
- Bar area includes multiple entrances, with bathrooms, hallways, and special lighting.
- State-of-the-art digital video and audio system to record and playback training scenarios.
- Portable drug lab.
- Sound effect system.
- Non-toxic, smoke special effects available.
- 3 remote control portable target systems.
- Controlled lighting to simulate daytime or evening conditions.
- Indoor simunitions range for shoot/don't shoot scenarios.
