- We are currently working on the POST FY 23-24 budget, currently we are only getting 15% in indirect fees, however we have submitted justification for that to increase to 20%, our reasoning is the cost of good has risen, this will help offset those increased costs..
- ICI Program ICI Core Course is in session now, we have Homicide OIS and Sex Assault coming up.
- Basic SWAT will start their course October 3rd.
