Course Description:

The Robert Presley Institute of Criminal Investigation (ICI) Sexual Assault Course is a 40-hour ICI Foundation Specialty Course designed to increase knowledge of sexual assault and improve investigative techniques while providing specialized skills and knowledge necessary to collaboratively, effectively, and objectively conduct investigations unique to sexual assault. The course is recommended for station detectives and specialized sexual assault investigators as it teaches the reporting process for prosecution by means of experience-based learning. This course provides instruction in the ethical challenges specific to sexual assault investigations, types of information that can be recovered using computer forensics, and the SART model. This training also provides investigators with tools to recognize how sexual assault investigations may impact their professional and personal lives and develop healthy coping strategies to support their well-being. At the conclusion of this training course, the investigator will be knowledgeable in the field of sexual assault investigations, be able to employ proper investigative techniques, prepare reports for filing, and prepare a case for prosecution.

Learning Outcomes:

- Interpret and apply sexual assault related laws
- Competently exercise their investigative skills in sexual assault cases to increase the likelihood of successful prosecution under California law
- Identify the importance of a sexual assault forensic medical examination as an investigative resource
- Understand victim dynamics and counterintuitive behaviors
- Develop specific investigation and interrogation framing based on offender typology

*This course meets the training requirements of PC 13516(c) for detectives assigned to investigate cases of sexual assault.
